6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and of any proposed amendments including whether the rule implements a state statute for the first time:

The purpose of Liq 903.01 is to communicate when the prevailing price on goods purchased from a warehouse or at a commission liquor store is determined.

The Liquor Commission is proposing to align the rule with when our new Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system determines the purchase price. The prior ERP system determined the purchase price based on the date the order was shipped from the warehouse. The new ERP system determines the purchase price based on the date the order was placed. Sale prices change based on the Commission's promotional calendar and the price of products could be different on the date of shipment than the price displayed when the order was placed.

This new process brings more transparency to the ordering process and more clearly communicates the purchase price to the licensee.
